






Custom SOQL Query

- Returns a single XML document per matching record
- **Execute REST or CSV Bulk APIs**

CSV BULK API V2.0 Operation

- Simple interface to load large amounts of data and perform bulk queries
- Receive and return documents in CSV format.
- Select the intended operation through a drop down menu

🖯 Connector Shape 🛈

Use connector shapes to get data into and out of a process. Most processes have one "get" connector and one or more "send" connectors. The Connector shape uses a combination of predefined connection and operation components to establish where and how to get or send data.



Designing a Transaction

 All Database v2 shapes that are part of a transaction connect to the same connection component



Database v2 Connector Shape





Example Transaction using Try-catch and Branch

- 1. START TRANSACTION on a separate branch
- 2. Dynamic Update in a the Try path with Join Transaction selected
- 3. COMMIT TRANSACTION in the Try path
- 4. ROLLBACK TRANSACTION in the Catch path
- 5. Data obtained from an external source directed to the Dynamic Update path
