# 5 best practices to measure and manage technical debt

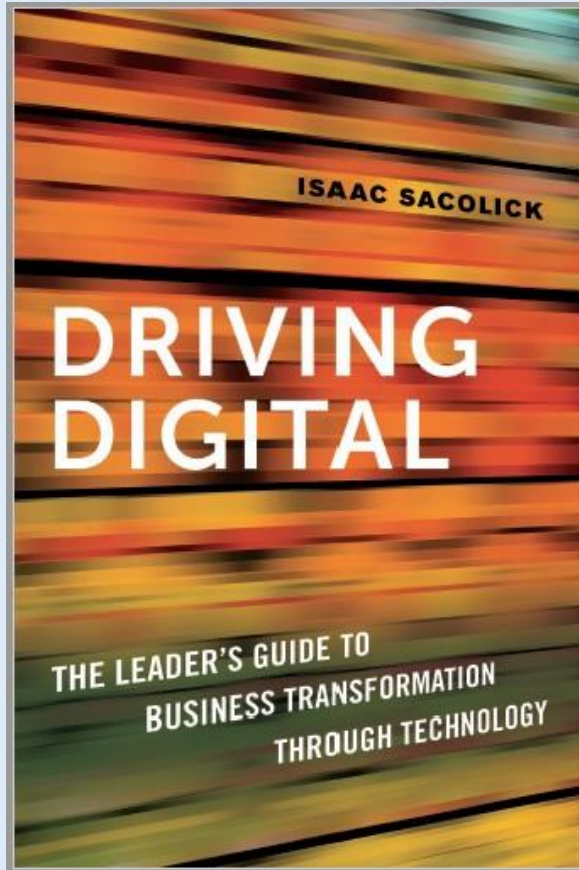


1. Manage technical debt starts by measuring it
2. Use release planning strategies to manage technical debt
3. Invest in devops CI/CD to make it easier to address technical debt
4. Plan “system upgrade” release cycles to address patching and upgrades
